To enter the building, you will be required to show your Covid status (vaccination, negative Covid test or proof of natural immunity) on your Covid pass to demonstrate that you are at lower risk of transmitting the virus to others.

Travelling from England? Please see the government website [here](#) on NHS Covid passes for further details.

Coming from abroad? Please take a lateral flow test within 48 hours of your event and register the result on the NHS website [here](#). Many national governments have created their own Covid Passports which international travellers may use to prove their Covid status.

If you do not have access to a mobile phone, have received the vaccination outside of the UK or are not registered with a GP in England you can present a hard copy of official documented proof for entry.
